

Cleaning Cages Process

- Rescue
- Windex or Got Pee
- Hand towel
- +/- Swiffer with wet pad

- 1.) Leave animal cage card in cage to signify that cage is dirty and needs cleaned (if bedding is still in cage leave cage card on top of bedding)
- 2.) Make sure cage doors always remain closed as they are a safety hazard
- 3.) Spray walls, floor, ceiling, and glass door inside and out of cage with Rescue and let soak for at least one minute
- 4.) Wipe down with hand towel
- 5.) Use Got Pee or Windex to clean inside and outside of glass cage door
- 6.) For dog runs use wet swiffer to go over rescue that was sprayed on the floor of the runs
- 7.) If mats were used in the heated cages, use dawn dish soap, scrub brush, and critical care sink to clean
- 8.) Shut and latch cage door after cleaning, put bedding in laundry bin, and throw away cage card
- 9.) This protocol does not apply to cages that housed infectious animals - ask CVT on duty for specific sanitation guidelines for those cases
