

## Cleaning Basket Muzzles Process

- 1) Clean all muzzles in cottage kennel sink - not in treatment area or critical care.
- 2) Do not soak muzzles -this causes the leather to stretch and the buckles to break.
- 3) If the muzzle has an insert, remove the insert to clean it. (Put it back in when dry)
- 4) Hold plastic part of muzzle under the slowly running water. Use a small amount of dish soap and the brushes in the silver bucket to scrub out each section of the muzzle (toothbrush and orange bottle type brush).
- 5) Keep strap and buckle dry as possible -if the strap is dirty use a damp cloth to clean it.
- 6) Once the muzzle and insert are clean, dry them with a hand towel. Place the insert back inside the muzzle.
- 7) Spray 1-2 squirts of Miltex spray lube on the buckle of the muzzle. (It is under the kennel sink)
- 8) Place the muzzle back in the area it came from in the correct size location
