

## Oral Health Hygiene and Prophylaxis Anesthesia Prep Visit Process

### Scheduling:

- 2 weeks prior to procedure (no more than 3 weeks and no less than 1 week)
- If the owner is willing at well visit within 30 days, a separate anesthesia prep visit does not need to be done. This prep process should be followed at time of wellness visit. Owner will receive a 50\$ credit towards the hygiene procedure for scheduling at the time of the wellness visit.
- Reservation fee at time of scheduling is the treatment plan amount. Only refundable if the patient develops a condition that causes anesthetic risk or HPVC must cancel (not reschedule) the dentistry visit.
  - Dogs Having Prep and Scheduling At Their Wellness Visit: reservation fee- \$500
  - Cats Having Prep and Scheduling At Their Wellness Visit: reservation fee-\$452
  - *Note: On the Clover you will run the total cost of the wellness invoice AND the reservation fee. In eVet you first enter the payment for the invoice. This closes the invoice. Then enter a second transaction "make deposit" of the (\$500 or \$452) and include a note "oral hygiene-date". This will leave a credit of \$500 or \$452 on the client's account.*
  - Dogs Scheduling At Another Time: reservation fee- \$645
  - Cats Scheduling At Another time: reservation fee-\$597
  - *Note: if client would like to prepay for Sealant, please let them know we will note on the chart they would like Sealant, we do not ask for payment for that until day of in case a different procedure is recommended*

### Treatment Plans:

- Owner is given a paper copy of treatment plan graphic if they are present, otherwise sent electronically. This graphic is easiest to get by clicking the person icon on the top right hand corner of eVet, selecting Practice Documents and choosing the appropriate plan.
- When the owner schedules, create a treatment plan titled "oral hygiene & prophylaxis" that includes:
  - If scheduled during well - Either **ESToralhygieneprophyK9** or **ESToralhygieneprophyFEL**
  - If prep not done at well - must have 2 packages: either **ESToralhygieneprophyK9** or **ESToralhygieneprophyFEL** AND **ESToralhygieneanesprep**
  - If owner present they must sign then, otherwise they are to sign at anesthesia prep visit

**Package Charges:** Either **oralhygieneanesprepwithwellness** or **oralhygieneanesprep**

### Blood Test:

- If wellness bloodwork due, charge and choose diagnostics for the pet as you normally would for wellness, then remove blood panels/inventory from prep package.
- If pet not due for well care diagnostics then perform IDEXXIHchem10well and 3559 (in package).
- If >30 days since wellness bloodwork then perform IDEXXIHchem10well and a 3559
- Note that cats must have record of FELV/FIV negative on file

### Dog and Cat PVP Protocol:

- Send home two pouches of Tricky Treats for dogs- if going home with pills
- Use white envelope for tablets and put capped/labeled syringes in a tall pill bottle that is labeled. Highlight CAPITALIZED giving times- using one color highlighter only. Once the envelope has a 2nd signature, seal it shut. Syringes are to be labeled with the times using a sticker.
- All pets must go home with Cerenia and Gabapentin unless MEDICALLY contraindicated, trazodone is only to be used if the patient currently takes trazodone to come to the visit. Patients currently using PVPs should use their normal PVP protocol
- Remove any inventory items not used or prescribed

### Paperwork for Owners (Other Than Treatment Plan):

- Give owner the Your Pet's Anesthesia - What To Expect handout. Find under the person icon in eVet - Practice Documents.
- Remind owner that they will be receiving an email from you in about a week (the charge will trigger this as a callback reminder!) with what to expect and a required consent form that they need to submit by 48 hrs prior to the procedure - email template: Anesthesia Consent and What To Expect Email- Dentistry

- On the **callback reminder day**, send owner email from pet's account using email template "Anesthesia Consent & What To Expect" -blue button email, choose template
- Monday mornings- a surgical team member verifies consent form received (by 10 am) - if it is not, client must be contacted immediately

Give ½ tablet by mouth/in treat 2 hours prior to admission Give 1 tablet by mouth/in treat Extra dose: Give ½ tablet if needed at home after procedure	<b>Cerenia 160 mg Tablet -qty 1</b> Night Before: Give 1/2 tab by mouth with supper Extra dose: If not eating well by morning after give ½ tab by mouth
